PIPELINE IMPACTS

Impacts from pipeline construction and from the maintenance of the permanent rights-of-way include:

- Lower property values
- Restrictions on property use
- Blocked access to homes and land
- Damage to public roads
- Increased traffic accidents and injuries
- Crossing of vulnerable watersheds
- Threats to drinking water supplies (public and private)
- Installation of 24/7 compressor stations
- Dust, noise, fumes, diesel spills and more ...
